Kannan Srinivasan is a scholar at Australia's Monash Asia Institute, where he is completing books on the Hindu Right and on money laundering and capital flight. Born in Bombay and educated in India and the United Kingdom, he was Senior Editor of India's *Financial Express* from 1988 to 1994, writing on energy and on economic policy. He has contributed more than 25 articles to academic journals, especially *Economic and Political Weekly*, and more than 500 op-eds and front-page stories in the *Wall Street Journal*, *Times of India*, *Economic Times*, *Financial Express*, *Business Standard*, *The Hindu*, et al.
